



Public Notice – 2018 Bellbird Park State Secondary College Council Election

Bellbird Park State Secondary College is an Independent Public School, meaning we are a member of an elite group of Government schools which is administrated by a School Council. Independent Public Schools are provided with greater autonomy in decision-making and increased capacity to work in new ways to maximise learning outcomes.

The official members of the Bellbird Park SSC School Council Mr Michael West (Principal) and Ms Carly Lawrence (President of P & C Association) give the school community public notice that there will be an election for parent representatives on the Bellbird Park SSC School Council.

An election for two (2) Parent representatives, will be held at a meeting:

- on Monday 26 March 2018 at 5pm {Hospitality/E Block}.

To be eligible for election as an elected parent, a person must:

- not be the principal of the school or the Parents and Citizens' Association (P&C) president;
- have not been convicted of an indictable offence, unless the Minister gives approval under the Act (s.93);
- attend a meeting called for the purpose of electing parent members;
- be the parent of a student attending the school; and
- submit a completed nomination on time.
