Purpose and Eligibility Requirements

As part of our on-going commitment to excellence in student achievement, Bellbird Park State Secondary College is pleased to offer scholarship opportunities to year 7 students within the areas of Academic, Sports and The Arts. Students will need to have demonstrated a commitment to their studies, as exemplified through their performance in the identified scholarship criteria. Students will also need to demonstrate an ability to contribute to the BPSSC culture and a willingness to adhere to the school values of Responsibility, Integrity, Support and Effort.

Available Scholarships

- **i. Academic Scholarships:** Recipients must be able to demonstrate excellence (an achievement of A in year 6) in Mathematics, Science, English and Humanities.
- **ii. Sports Scholarships:** Recipients must be able to demonstrate a minimum of regional representation at State Championships.
- **iii. The Arts:** Recipients must be able to demonstrate excellence in an area of arts or languages e.g., dance, drama, music, visual, and/or media arts.

Scholarship Conditions

Students who apply for a scholarship at Bellbird Park State Secondary College must meet the clearly defined criteria as stated below.

The successful scholarship recipient will demonstrate:

- An impeccable behaviour record.
- Commitment to the pursuit of excellence reflected in their dedication to achieve according to their potential.
- Commitment to the leadership role that is implicit for all scholarship holders. This includes being a positive role model for younger students through a commitment to their studies.
- Understanding of the ambassadorial role of a scholarship holder in representing the school.
- Support for all aspects of the Uniform Policy reflected by wearing the school uniform with pride.
- Support for all aspects of school life and a willingness to accept the broad range of opportunities offered at Bellbird Park State Secondary College.
- Commitment to the four core values of the school Responsibility, Integrity, Support, Effort.

Scholarship Expectations

Students applying for a Bellbird Park State Secondary College Scholarship should:

- Demonstrate achievement in academics according to the student's potential to achieve.
- Demonstrate continued effort and sustained commitment to improving academic performance.
- Be prepared to participate in nominated school-based activities and events as notified.
- Show support to the leadership role that is implicit for all scholarship holders. This includes being a positive role model for younger students, displaying leadership by encouraging and supporting other students, and fostering group and school spirit. This also requires the student and parents to demonstrate support for the values of the Bellbird Park State Secondary College both at school and outside school.
- Show an awareness of, and appreciation for, school life and a willingness to accept the broad range of opportunities offered at Bellbird Park State Secondary College .
- Be committed to the school values.

Parents or carers of students accepting a scholarship must be willing to:

- Provide support to school activities by volunteering to assist in events and activities when possible.
- Be committed to the school values.
- Support the student to ensure the above commitments are achieved.

- The Principal will review committee recommendations and will have the final say on all scholarship recipients. No correspondence will be entered into, once the decisions have been made.
- Successful applicants will be contacted by the school and further information will be provided.
