This funding will be used to

- To ensure that all students receive one year of growth for one year of input across all subjects.
- Improve relative gain for year 7 and 9 NAPLAN Reading, Writing and Numeracy \geq like schools.
- Increase the percentage of students of students in NAPLAN U3B's in Year 7 and 9 Reading, Writing and Numeracy.
- Value-add (\geq National Growth) PAT Reading and Maths over a 12-month period – January to December 2019.
- To ensure all students to meet or exceed the College attendance rate $\geq 95\%$, and reduce students attending $< 85\%$.
- Decrease the number of out-of-school suspensions.

Our initiatives include

- Embed a culture that promotes learning that includes rigorous attendance monitoring.
- Implement whole school literacy and numeracy frameworks to support teachers across all learning areas. Develop teacher capability across literacy and numeracy.
- Appoint dedicated co-teachers + Literacy, Numeracy, and ICP coordinators.
- Continue with our unique initiative to out-of-school suspensions → BPSSC PARC.
- Continue to provide focussed and intensive support for students requiring additional support → expand Reading Hub/MacqLit program.
- Improve communication and support with our community via appointment of Community Liaison Officer and a Community Education Counsellor.
- Provide additional support to our students by appointing a second FT Guidance Officer.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Appointing dedicated staff to coordinate Reading Hub/MacqLit program.
- Engage additional and qualified staff to implement PARC program.
- Engage additional staff to support our co-teacher initiative in the core curriculum areas.
- Support learning through additional targeted teacher aide allocation.
- Provide TRS to enable teachers/leaders to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations.
