### Why participate in this program?

Students will select from a range of General Preparation subjects in Year 10 to support a transition into General Subjects in Year 11 and Year 12 for an ATAR and direct entry to university. Gaining direct entry in to university is highly competitive and our program will ensure that your student reaches their pathway goals.

Students selected in this program will have ongoing mentoring with the Senior Schooling Academic Team to monitor their subject selections for Year 10 and will receive tailored support for their their Year 11 and 12 subject selection in 2024 for 2025.
